



## BUILDING COMMITTEE CHARTER

Charter presented at June 6, 2007 business meeting:

***The Building Committee of Centreville Baptist Church is charged with the following:***

1. **Assessment** – Conduct a thorough review and analysis of:
  - a. How our site and physical facilities, as currently constructed, impact the ministry programs today.
  - b. What changes or additions to our facilities are needed to support ministry in the future.

The committee will provide a report to the church of their findings and recommendations on the best ways a new facility or renovation could continue to support God's work at CBC.

2. **Planning** – After the assessment is completed and recommendations approved, the committee will study what kind of changes, renovations or additions to our facilities are needed, how it can be accomplished, financing options, etc. that will support our mission of making fully devoted disciples of Jesus Christ. That plan will be presented for feedback, adjusting, confirmation and final approval by the leadership and congregation.
3. **Construction** – After the plan has been approved, the committee will exercise oversight in the renovation of current facilities and/or construction of new facilities.

***The church body of Centreville Baptist Church is charged with the following:***

1. **Prayer** - The church body needs to be in constant prayer asking God to give the committee wisdom, direction, and strength in leading our efforts to provide the physical resources needed to support the ministries that help us to accomplish our mission of making fully devoted disciples of Jesus Christ.
2. **Input** – When meetings are held or your input is solicited, please make efforts to attend them and to offer feedback after spending time in prayer.
3. **Walk by Faith** – This project will be a great walk of faith as we look to Him to lead us as we work for His good pleasure. May we be found walking by faith, not by sight.
