



Congregational Care Ministry Input

- a) To assist in establishing believers by welcoming, connecting, and caring for God's people and thereby glorifying God by making fully devoted disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ.
- b) To have all that attend experience a genuine sense of being welcome from the time they arrive on campus.
- c) The facility and grounds should provide environments, large and small, that encourage hospitality by our church family to our visitors and to one another.
- d) An overall environment including physical spaces, equipment, and furnishings throughout the facility and grounds that invites, encourages, and supports "connecting" activities and communication for meeting and getting to know one another.
- e) Various places for comfortably connecting through conversation and prayer should be provided, as well as appropriate environments for various types of counseling that offer privacy, convenience, and urgency. All this encourages and provides for the building of relationships among our people. Specific areas for prayer and counseling are needed.
- f) Encourage the church family in caring for others by implementing the "one another's" of Holy Scripture and thereby truly loving one another.
- g) An updated or larger kitchen and fellowship hall would greatly contribute to the building of community and connectedness within the church family.
- h) Better designed and appropriately located counseling ministry areas are needed.
- i) Dedicated prayer rooms and prayer areas throughout the facility are lacking.
